Challenges

Before implementing Previstar, an Everbridge solution, West Bengal used paper-based plans that needed to be manually updated and maintained. The plans were static, time-consuming to operationalize, and far from optimal in a disaster. The number of agencies involved and the complexity of managing available resources, such as hospital beds, tents, and emergency food packs, was a huge undertaking that required daily management.

Additionally, different departments were working in silos when disaster struck. It was difficult to get everyone to come together in real time, leading to inefficient management of disasters and increased impact.

West Bengal needed to digitize its operations to improve efficiency and effectiveness. The digitalization of all parts of state administration was a driving force in this project. The case for digitalization was especially strong in the Disaster Management Department as their activities help to save lives and livelihoods across the state in the event of any type of incident. Also, the number of disasters was increasing, and new threats were being considered and planned for, such as chemical and biological incidents.

To meet the complex requirements of disaster preparedness in West Bengal, the Disaster Management Department (DMD) chose to partner with Everbridge and implement the Previstar Continual Preparedness System—a solution for incident management that is trusted by disaster management agencies across the world.

- Planning
- Response
- Notification
- Decision support
- Automation of calamity assessment

During Cyclone Amphan, a huge number of trees were uprooted and caused damage to houses, businesses, and roads. The state needed to locate tree cutters with the right skills and equipment to help remove fallen trees. Prior to implementing Previstar CPS, this would have been a very difficult and time-consuming activity, as most people had left the cities and gone back to their villages to be with family at this critical time. Fortuantely, CPS helped locate tree cutters using geolocation and contact details. The use of CPS helped to clear roads faster, so vital supplies could be transported to the worst hit regions, helping to save lives and livelihoods.
