FEMA RELATED GRANT PROGRAMS

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANTS (EMPG)

The Emergency Management Performance Grant provides state, local, tribal and territorial emergency management agencies in enhancing and sustaining all-hazards emergency management capabilities.

PORT SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (PSGP)

This grant provides funding to state, local and private-sector partners to help protect critical port infrastructure from terrorism, enhance maritime domain awareness, improve port-wide maritime security risk management, and maintain or reestablish maritime security mitigation protocols that support port recovery and resiliency capabilities.

HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (HSGP)

The Homeland Security Grant includes a suite of risk-based grants to assist state, local, tribal and territorial efforts in preventing, protecting against, mitigating, responding to and recovering from

acts of terrorism and other threats. This grant provides grantees with the resources required for implementation of the National Preparedness System and working toward the National Preparedness Goal of a secure and resilient nation.

The following three grant programs comprise of the HSGP:

STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM (SHSP)

This program provides funding to support the implementation of risk-driven, capabilities-based State Homeland Security Strategies to address capability targets.

URBAN AREAS STRATEGIC INITIATIVE PROGRAM (UASI)

The UASI Program assists high-threat, high-density Urban Areas in efforts to build and sustain the capabilities necessary to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism.

OPERATION STONEGARDEN (OPSG) PROGRAMS

This program provides funding to enhance cooperation and coordination among state, local, tribal, territorial, and federal law enforcement agencies to jointly enhance security along the United States land and water borders.

HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM

The purpose of HMGP is to help communities implement hazard mitigation measures following a Presidential Major Disaster Declaration in the areas of the state, tribe, or territory requested by the Governor or Tribal Executive. The key purpose of this grant program is to enact mitigation measures that reduce the risk of loss of life and property from future disasters.

TRANSIT SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (TSGP)

The Transit Security Grant Program (TSGP) provides funds to eligible publicly owned operators of public transportation systems (which include intra-city bus, commuter bus, ferries, and all forms of passenger rail) to protect critical surface transportation infrastructure and the traveling public from acts of terrorism and to increase the resilience of transit infrastructure.

BUILDING RESILIENT INFRASTRUCTURE AND COMMUNITIES (BRIC)

Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) will support states, local communities, tribes and territories as they undertake hazard mitigation projects, reducing the risks they face from disasters and natural hazards. BRIC is a new FEMA pre-disaster hazard mitigation program that replaces the existing Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) program.

PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS (PHEP)

The Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) cooperative agreement is a critical source of funding for state, local, and territorial public health departments. Since 2002, the PHEP cooperative agreement has provided assistance to public health departments across the nation. This helps health departments build and strengthen their abilities to effectively respond to a range of public health threats, including infectious diseases, natural disasters, and biological, chemical, nuclear, and radiological events.

ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANTS (AFG)

AFGs provide financial assistance directly to fire departments and nonaffiliated EMS organizations to enhance their capabilities with respect to fire and fire-related hazards. Its primary goal is to help fire departments and nonaffiliated EMS organizations meet their firefighting and emergency-response needs.

TRIBAL HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (THSGP)

The Tribal Homeland Security Grant Program (THSGP) plays an important role in the implementation of the National Preparedness System by supporting the building, sustaining and delivery of core capabilities essential to achieving the National Preparedness Goal of a secure and resilient nation.
